
Michigan Early Middle Colleges

An **Early Middle College (EMC)** is a Michigan Department of Education (MDE) approved five-year program of study. EMCs work closely with postsecondary partners to provide students with an opportunity earn a high school diploma and one or more of the following EMC outcome awards:

- 60 transferable college credits
- An associate degree
- A professional certification
- The Michigan Early Middle College Association (MEMCA) technical certificate
- Participation in a registered
 apprenticeship

PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF EMC SCHOOLS/PROGRAMS BY EMC TYPE, 2020-21




Early Middle College High School means a stand alone public high school, where 100% of the pupils are enrolled as EMC pupils. **Early Middle College Program** is a high school program designed to serve less than 100% of the high school population.

EMC STUDENT ENROLLMENT




