SUBJECT: New State-Approved Observation Tool for Teacher Evaluation

The Michigan Transformative Framework for Professional Growth has been added to the list of state-approved educator evaluation tools for teachers.

MCL 380.1249(5) of Michigan's educator evaluation law states that the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) shall establish and maintain a list of teacher evaluation tools meeting the legislative guidelines of being reliable, valid, and efficacious. State administrative rules 380.21, 380.22, and 380.23 establish the standards and procedures for adding and removing an evaluation tool from the list. The rules include a process for a school district, intermediate school district, public school academy, or private organization to submit an evaluation tool for review for placement on the list.

After successful review, the teacher evaluation tool of the Michigan Elementary and Middle School Principal Association (MEMSPA), the Michigan Transformative Framework for Professional Growth, was approved by MDE for addition to the state-approved teacher evaluation list.
