O Administering the Test

If you're administering the tests for the first time:

1. Identify your district's English Learner (EL) Assessment Coordinator. If you don't know who this is, ask your building or district administrators. Someone must be identified in this role at the district level. The identified person may turn out to be you, but you need to ask the question and determine this at the local level.

- 2. Download and read the <u>Understanding the WIDA Assessments</u> chapter of the Assessment Coordinator Training Guide.
- 3. If you're administering the test, work with your District EL Assessment Coordinator to determine your training needs. Your District EL Assessment Coordinator will know the state's requirements and know how to get you set up with all the appropriate accounts you may need.
