**SUBJECT:** Online Learning Data Reporting Requirement for School Fiscal Year

Ending June 30, 2020

Local school districts, both traditional public school districts and public school academies, or intermediate school districts that offer virtual learning under section 21f of the state school aid act, or a school of excellence that is a cyber school as defined in MCL 380.551, are required to provide to the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) details on the per-pupil costs of operating the virtual learning by vendor type and virtual learning model. This report is required by section 18(12) of the state school aid act (MCL 388.1618).

Districts must submit this information by January 28, 2021 via a data collection form, which can be found at the following web address: <a href="https://www.michigan.gov/mde-21fcollection">www.michigan.gov/mde-21fcollection</a>.
