SUBJECT: Notification of Online Learning Data Request for School Fiscal Year
Ending June 30, 2021

Pursuant to the [State School Aid Act, Section 388.1618 \(12\)](#) passed by the state legislature, a district or intermediate school district that offers learning under [Section 21f](#), or a school of excellence that is a cyber school, as defined in [Section 551](#), is required to submit to the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) a report that details the per-pupil costs of operating the virtual learning by vendor type and virtual learning model.

Districts must submit the report to MDE via a data collection form by January 28, 2022. The data collection form can be found at the following web address: <http://www.michigan.gov/mde-21fcollection>. If districts have a MEIS account, they may use their login; if not, please log in as a guest.
