## **SUBJECT:** Postsecondary Enrollment Funding

Section 64b of the State School Aid Act provides \$1,750,000 for supplemental payments to districts for students that take a college course while in high school. The purpose of the funding is to increase the number of pupils who are college and career ready upon high school graduation.

To receive funding, districts should submit the Section 64b Claim Worksheet, which can be found on the CEPI website, <a href="http://www.michigan.gov/cepi">www.michigan.gov/cepi</a>, either under the MSDS Technical Section or the Teacher Student Data Link Help & Training section.

Districts may receive \$10 per credit, up to three credits, when a student enrolls in a college course and an additional \$30 per pupil per course if the student successfully completes the course and is awarded both high school and postsecondary credit for the course. It is recommended that you wait until the course is completed to fill out the claim worksheet to ensure you will receive full credit.
