

Planning for Test Day

SAT Extended Time

For SAT with Essay, the standard schedule includes testing room doors closing at 8:00 AM for pre-admin activities and testing beginning at 8:30 AM. Schools may alter the start time by 30 minutes and therefore close testing room doors as early as 7:30 AM or as late as 8:30 AM, and they may start testing any time between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM EST. Schools must contact the SAT School Day Customer Support (866-870-3127) for consideration and approval to start earlier or later than these times. The start time applies to standard test takers as well as accommodated test takers in both the primary and make up administrations. For SAT, there are three types of extended time accommodations.

Students may be approved for

- 1) reading extended time;
- 2) mathematics extended time; or
- 3) writing extended time.

➤ EXTENDED TIME READING (entire test)

Students testing with either 50% or 100% extended time will test over 2 days between April 12–15, 2016. Testing must occur on two consecutive days during that window. The most common accommodations are for 50% extended time or 100% extended time. The chart reflects the testing time for each section, including the standard breaks.
