We've received over 4,572 applications so far, and we want to hear from more providers.

One of the biggest reasons providers said they decided **not** to apply in April was because of the requirement to discount tuition and not charge families to hold a spot. Both of those requirements were removed in May. We hope that makes the grant more valuable to providers who are trying to open their doors. Please help us spread the word.
