P-20 System and Student Transitions

SUBJECT: Section 61c Grant Funding Eligibility

The State Legislature allocated \$2,500,000 in the <u>State School Aid Act, P.A. 94 of 1979</u>, as amended, <u>Section 61c</u>, to eligible career education planning districts for the career and technical education skilled trades initiative. To be eligible to receive funding under this section, at least 50 percent of the area served by a career education planning district must be located in an intermediate district that did not levy a vocational education millage in 2018.

Only the following districts meet the legislative designated criteria and are eligible to apply for these grant funds:
