SUBJECT: Technology Readiness Infrastructure Grant (TRIG) State Survey Results

On May 13, 2015, the Michigan Association of Intermediate School Administrators' TRIG Operations Office released the 2015 TRIG State Survey Report. This report was developed from the responses received from all TRIG participating districts.

As a participating district in the TRIG for the 2014-2015 year, ISDs, LEAs, and PSAs agreed to five requirements for grant participation. Requirement four states that, "The district agrees to participate in any necessary surveys sent out by the TRIG Operations Office to inform the work of the various activities (maximum of three per fiscal year, October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015)." Earlier this spring, the TRIG Operations Office along with the support of the five TRIG consortia sent out a survey related to the various activities being undertaken to complete the goals of the TRIG grant. The responses provided by the districts will be used by the leadership of those activities and their advisory members to make critical decisions as they begin the third year of their work.
