This school year, the Office of Educator Excellence (OEE) is adding teachers of the Italian language to a growing list of teacher exchange programs offered through the Michigan Department of Education.

During the 2018-2019 school year, 15 individuals were employed as teachers of Mandarin Chinese and Spanish teacher exchange program. The exchange program now includes partnership with Taiwan, Spain, and Italy.

In accordance with the Top 10 in 10 Strategic Plan, Goal 3: This partnership seeks to benefit students and teachers alike, through collaboration, communication, and cooperation. With Michigan's focus on world language graduation requirements, internationalizing education, and the global economy, this program supports the need for more world language teachers.
