- End of Year
 - Lisa gave a reminder that the MSDS End of Year certification deadline June 30, 2020.
 - Lisa gave a reminder to code EMC graduating students with an exit status code 40 or 41.
 - Exit Status 40 is an on-track EMC graduate that has earned their high school diploma plus one of the following:
 - Associate Degree
 - 60 transferrable postsecondary credits
 - Professional certification
 - MEMCA Certificate
 - Right to participate in a registered apprenticeship
 - Students taking summer courses - 2020 Graduation must be entered by August 30, 2020; **CTE EMC Programs please follow dates posted on CTEIS.**
- EMC Annual Verification
 - Due June 1, 2020
 - A Memo went to Superintendents regarding EEM changes and an email to EMC Contacts and EEM Authorized Users. All EMC and postsecondary contact information must be entered/updated in the EEM.
 - CEPI working on glitch in EEM where some of the contact fields were not visible.
 - EEM authorized users have access to enter data into the EEM – districts can email Caitlin Groom GroomC@michigan.gov to find out who the EEM authorized user in their district is.
 - Consortia Reporting
 - Consortia will have entity codes. No changes to student reporting until fall. More guidance will come out in the summer.

 - Reporting Students in Grade 12 Twice, starting with new cohort
 - Age of EMC students – if they turn 20 before September 1, not eligible to generate FTE unless special education or significant barriers.
