- ✓ **Alcohol and Other Drugs and Tobacco Report:** Calculation of Average Age of Onset for first use of tobacco, alcohol, marijuana and first time being drunk (derived from HS #36, 37, 38, 39; MS #29, 30, 31, 32)
- ✓ **Alcohol and Other Drugs and Tobacco Report:** Reporting of perceived norms of closest friends (HS #79, 80, 81; MS #67, 68, 69)

 - Drank alcohol (HS #152; MS #137)
 - Used marijuana (HS #153; MS #138)
 - Used an illegal drug (HS #154; MS #139)

- ✓ Diabetes diagnosis (formerly HS #146; MS #133)
- ✓ Four Moral Order questions
 - Okay to steal (HS #151; MS #136)
 - Okay to cheat in school (HS #152; MS #137)
 - Okay to beat up others (HS #153; MS #138)
 - Important to be honest with parents (HS #154; MS #139)
