SUBJECT: Section 22i, subsection 3: Whole School Technology Pilot

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) invites applicants for the 2013-2014 Section 22i, subsection 3: Whole School Technology Pilot. Five million dollars in general fund dollars have been made available for this grant program from FY2013 State School Aid, P.A. 60. The following are criteria for eligibility:

PROVIDER:

All for-profit and not-for profit organizations that submit a Letter of Intent in accordance with the guidelines below that have the demonstrated ability and experience to meet the requirements of the grant are eligible to apply. Priority will be given to Michigan-based organizations.

SCHOOL:

All public school districts in the State of Michigan are eligible to submit Letters of Intent in accordance with the guidelines below. Intermediate school districts (ISDs) are eligible to submit a SCHOOL on behalf of students enrolled directly in ISD programs where the ISD receives state school aid on a Full Time Equivalency (FTE) basis.

- Please note the PROVIDER will be making final determinations of the SCHOOLS selected to participate in light of the economic and geographic diversity requirements.

An initial Letter of Intent is required to confirm eligibility once applications are made available in the Michigan Electronic Grants System, Plus (MEGS+). A sample Letter of Intent is included in the Request for Proposal which can be found at: <http://tinyurl.com/22iSub3RFB>. MEGS+ applications will be made available on September 16, 2013, to districts that have submitted a Letter of Intent. The MDE reserves the right to amend key dates associated with the grant.
