



Calculators for MME Spring 2007

If you wish to use a calculator on the ACT Mathematics Test, WorkKeys Applied Mathematics, or Michigan Mathematics, you are responsible for bringing it to the test and making sure it works properly. The test center will not provide calculators or batteries. *You* are responsible for knowing if your calculator is a permitted model. If you use a prohibited calculator your answer document will not be scored.

You may use any four-function, scientific, or graphing calculator, unless it has features described below.

Prohibited Calculators

- **Texas Instruments:** TI-89 ...TI 92
Including all model numbers that begin with TI-89 or TI 92
- **Hewlett-Packard:** hp 40G ... hp 48GII ... hp 49G ... hp 50G
Including all model numbers that begin with hp 40G, hp 49G or hp 50G
- **Casio:** Algebra fx 2.0 ... ClassPad 300 ... CFX-9970G
Including all model numbers that begin with CFX-9970G
- **Pocket organizers**
- **Handheld or laptop computers**
- **Electronic writing pads or pen-input devices—The Sharp EL 9600 is permitted.**
- **Calculators built into cell phones or other electronic communication devices**
- **Calculators with a typewriter keypad (keys in QWERTY format)—Calculators with letter keys not in QWERTY format are permitted.**
- **Calculators with built-in computer algebra systems**

Calculators Permitted with Modification

These types of calculators are permitted, but only after they are modified as noted:

- **Calculators with paper tape—Remove the tape.**
- **Calculators that make noise—Turn off the sound.**

- **Calculators that can communicate wirelessly with other calculators— Completely cover the infrared data port with heavy opaque material, such as duct tape or electrician's tape.**
Including Hewlett-Packard hp 38G series and hp 48G
- **Calculators that have power cords—Remove all power/electrical cords.**
