



## Michigan Dental Sealant Program

### All Grantees Data Report

2016-2017 School Year

Fiscal Year 2017

#### Report Purpose

This report is intended to provide a descriptive summary of the patient population serviced by grantees participating in the SEAL! Michigan Dental Sealant Program within the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services during the grant period October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017. Data was obtained from child-level forms submitted by grantees to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

Program-level data are provided in each table and include the total number of patient records with missing data for each reported element. Program Managers should examine areas to improve data quality and collection.

## Demographics Results

- A total of 6,677 students were screened between October 1, 2016 and September 30, 2017 with 47.1% being male and 52.3% being female.

- Students from kindergarten through 12th grades were screened, the majority coming from 1st and 2nd grade.
- The average age of the students was 8.5 years and the range was between 4 and 21 years.

- 28.7% of students were in need of early dental care due to a small cavity that was not causing pain.
- 7.5% of the students were in need of urgent dental care. This could have been due to severe decay or abscessed, painful or bleeding areas.

- 47.4% of screened students received at least one sealant on a first molar; 6.9% received one sealant, 9.7% received two sealants, 5.7% received three sealants and 25.1% received sealants on all four first molars.
- In total 9,614 sealants were placed on first molars.

- In total, 1,840 sealants were placed on second molars.
