

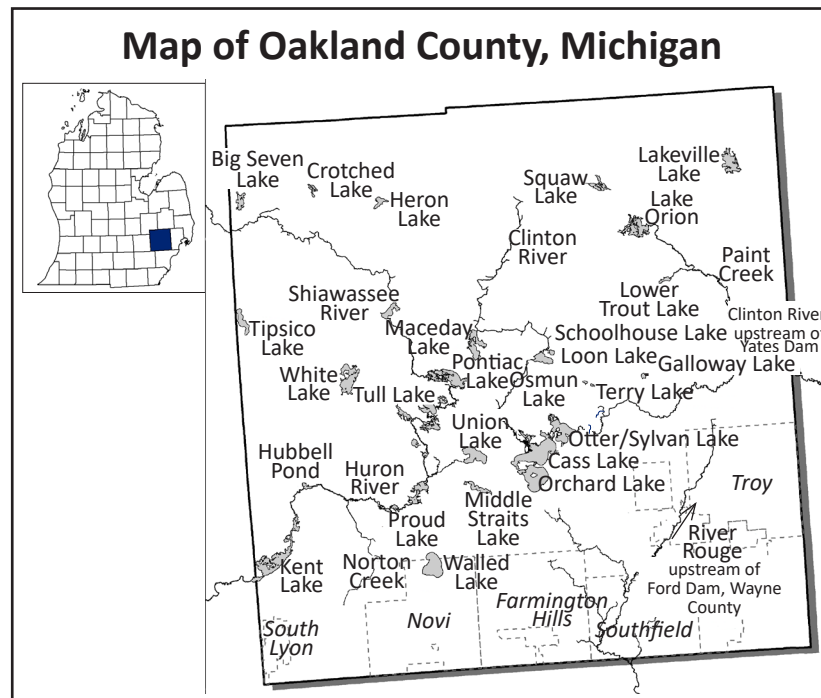
2018 *Eat Safe Fish Guide* Update

Southeast Michigan

Since the 2018 Eat Safe Fish Guide was printed, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) issued updated Eat Safe Fish guidelines for fish caught from the Huron River starting where North Wixom Road crosses in Oakland County to the mouth of the Huron River at Lake Erie in Wayne County. This also includes water bodies along and closely attached to the Huron River (see listings below). Updated guidelines are for Oakland, Livingston, Washtenaw, and Wayne Counties.

These updated guidelines replace those found in the 2018 Eat Safe Fish Guide. See the Eat Safe Fish Guide for other guidelines for these counties.

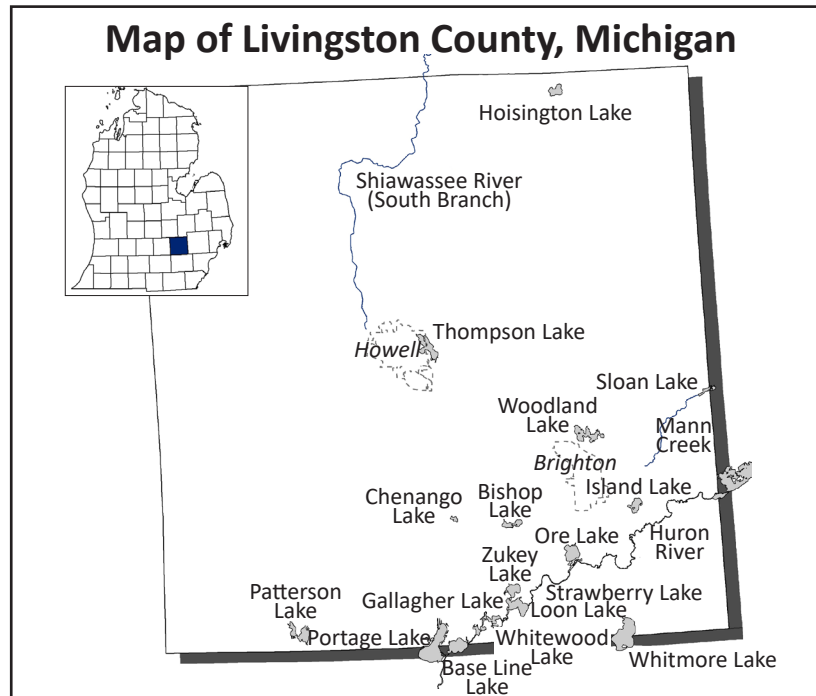

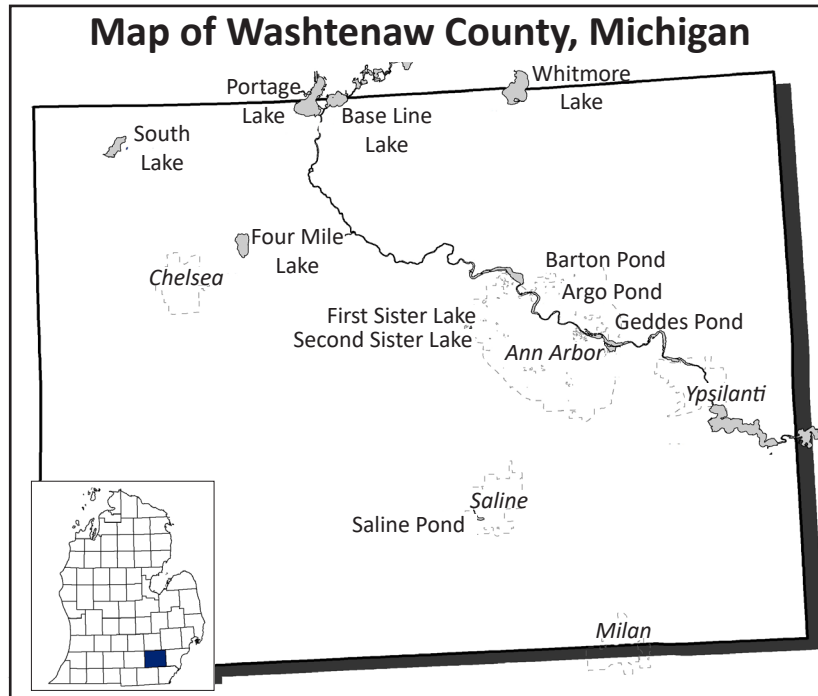

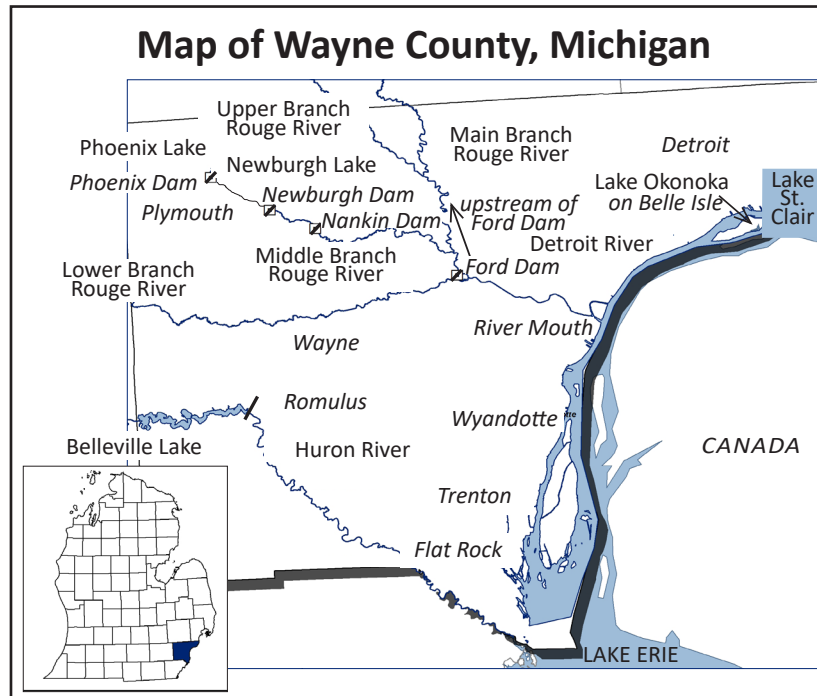
