



Statewide Volunteer Reception Center Directory



Purpose

Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Bureau of EMS, Trauma and Preparedness (BETP), Michigan Community Service Commission (MCSC), and Michigan State Police Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division (MSP-EMHSD) have jointly developed this Statewide Volunteer Reception Center (VRC) Directory to support local Emergency Operation Centers (EOCs), the State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC), and the Community Health Emergency Coordination Center (CHECC) response to emergencies in which volunteers may be needed. MDHHS human services county directors, local health departments (LHDs), emergency management (EM) agencies, and partners contributed to the directory development, identification of those having a lead role in VRC operations and the management of volunteers.

The directory is a living document and will be periodically updated. It is accessible on the <u>BETP</u>, <u>MCSC</u>, and <u>MSP</u> Websites.
