Dear WIC Vendor,

Please note, the Summer EBT for Children (SEBTC) Program for Summer 2021 has been suspended.

On March 11, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 was signed into law, extending Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT) through Summer 2021 for all P-EBT-eligible children. As both P-EBT and SEBTC are administered by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Michigan has decided to suspend the implementation of SEBTC this year to reduce redundancy and likely confusion among participants.


Michigan students eligible for free and reduced-price school meals will receive a P-EBT card with benefits; and the P-EBT teams at the Michigan Departments of Health and Human Service (MDHHS) and Education (MDE) will be administering this program extension in place of the SEBTC Program and Program staff.
