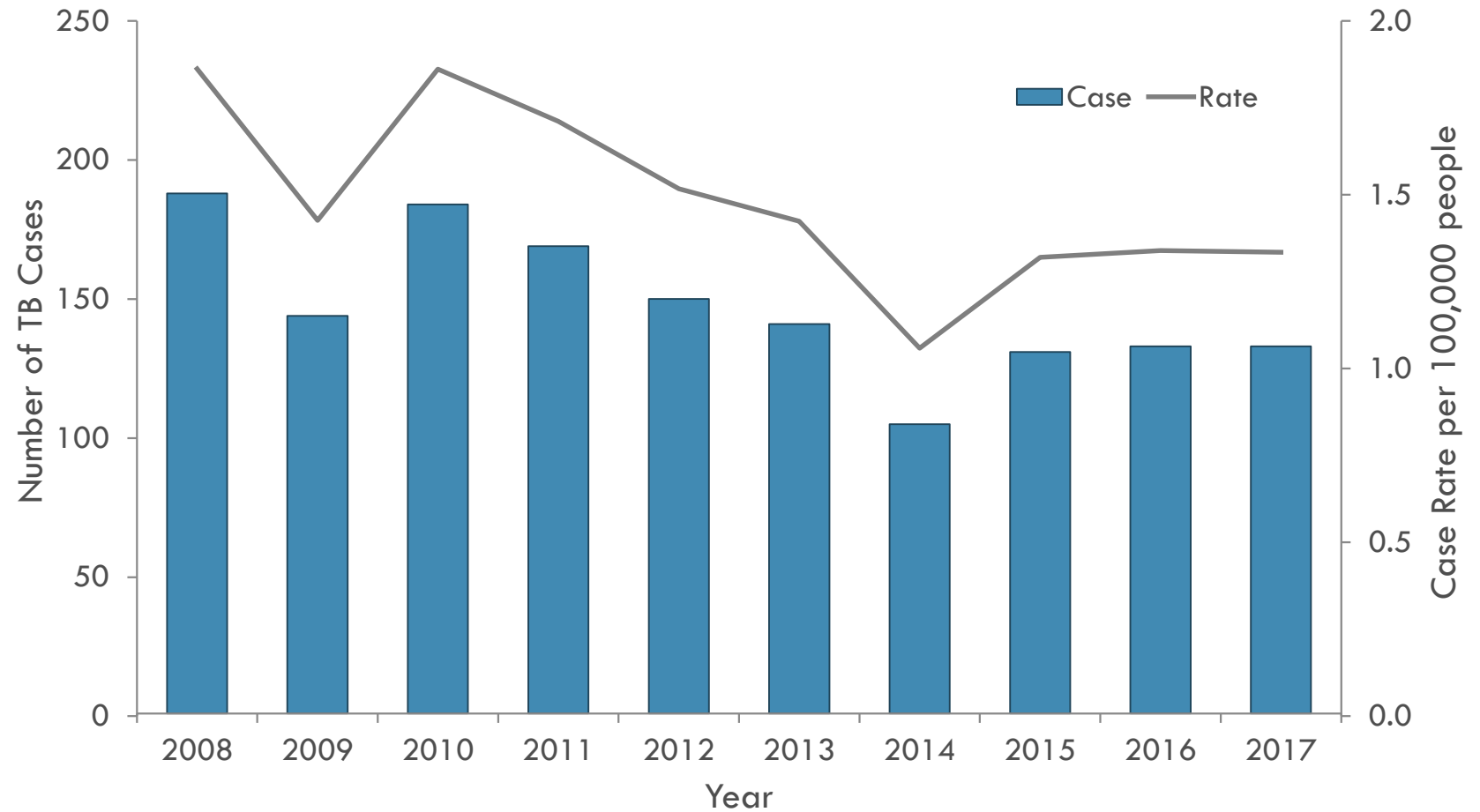
Reported TB Cases and Rates

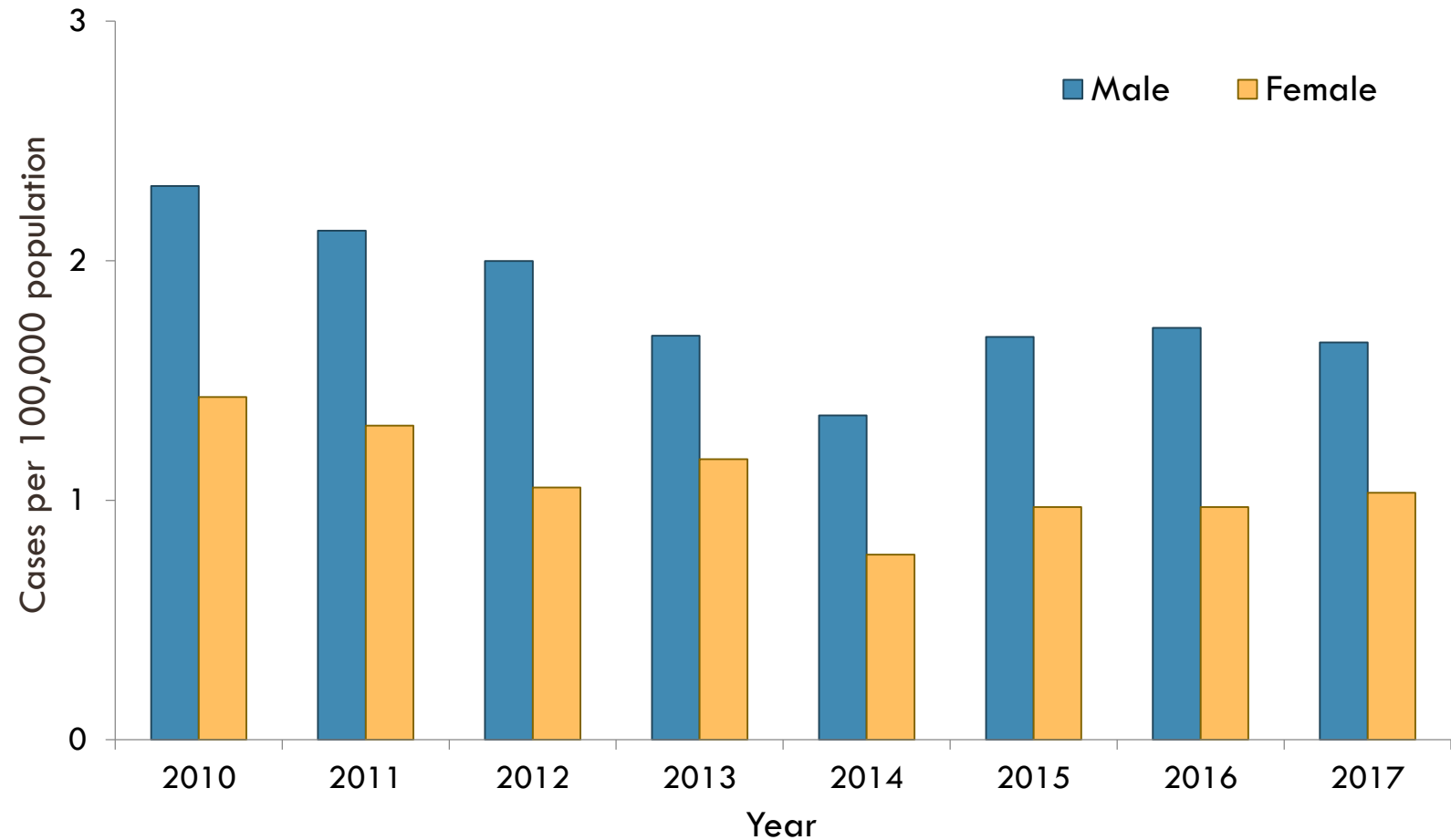


TB Rates by Gender

39% Female at a rate of 1.0 per 100,000



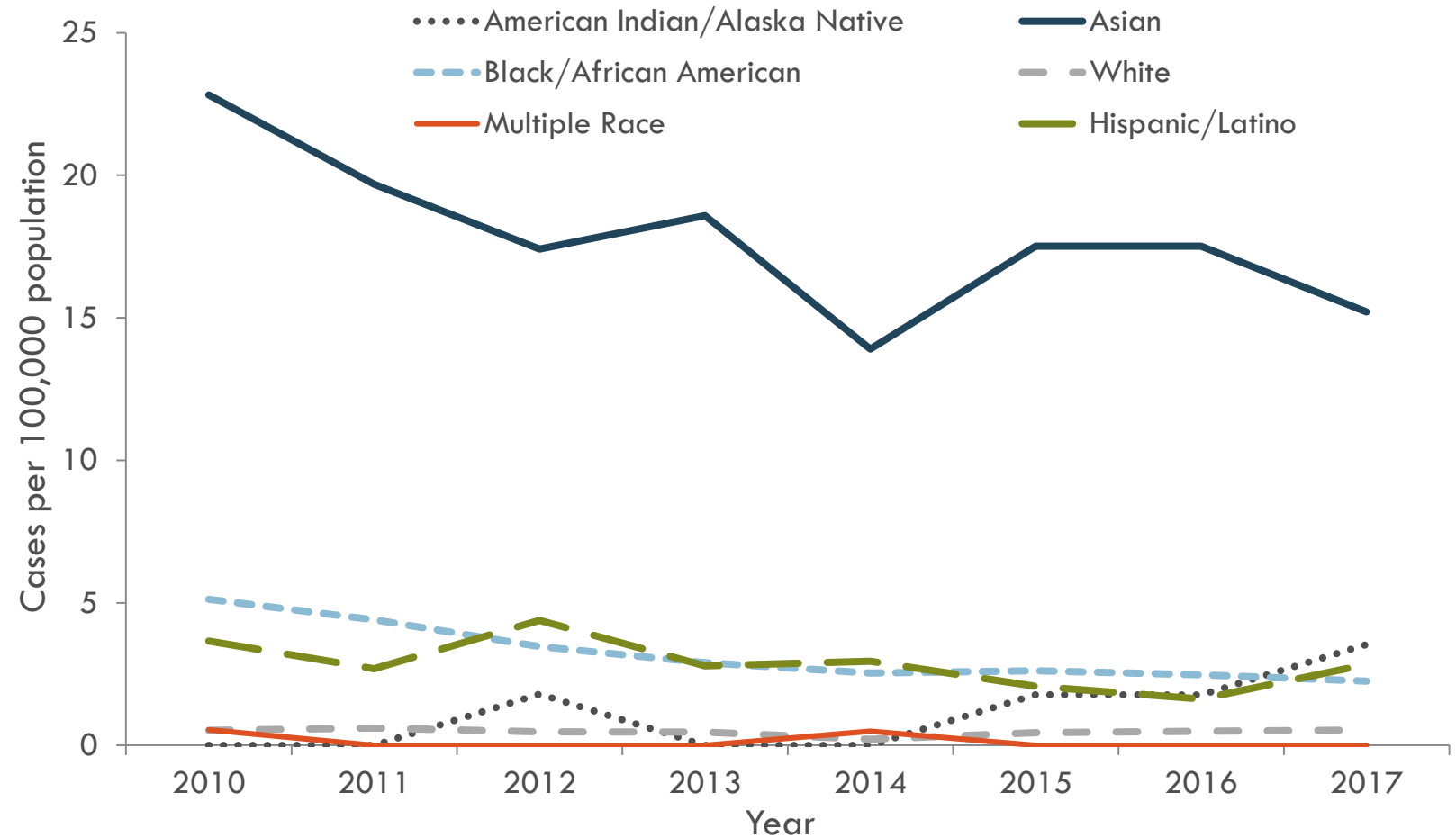
TB Rates by Race and Ethnicity

23% Black at a rate of 2.3 per 100,000

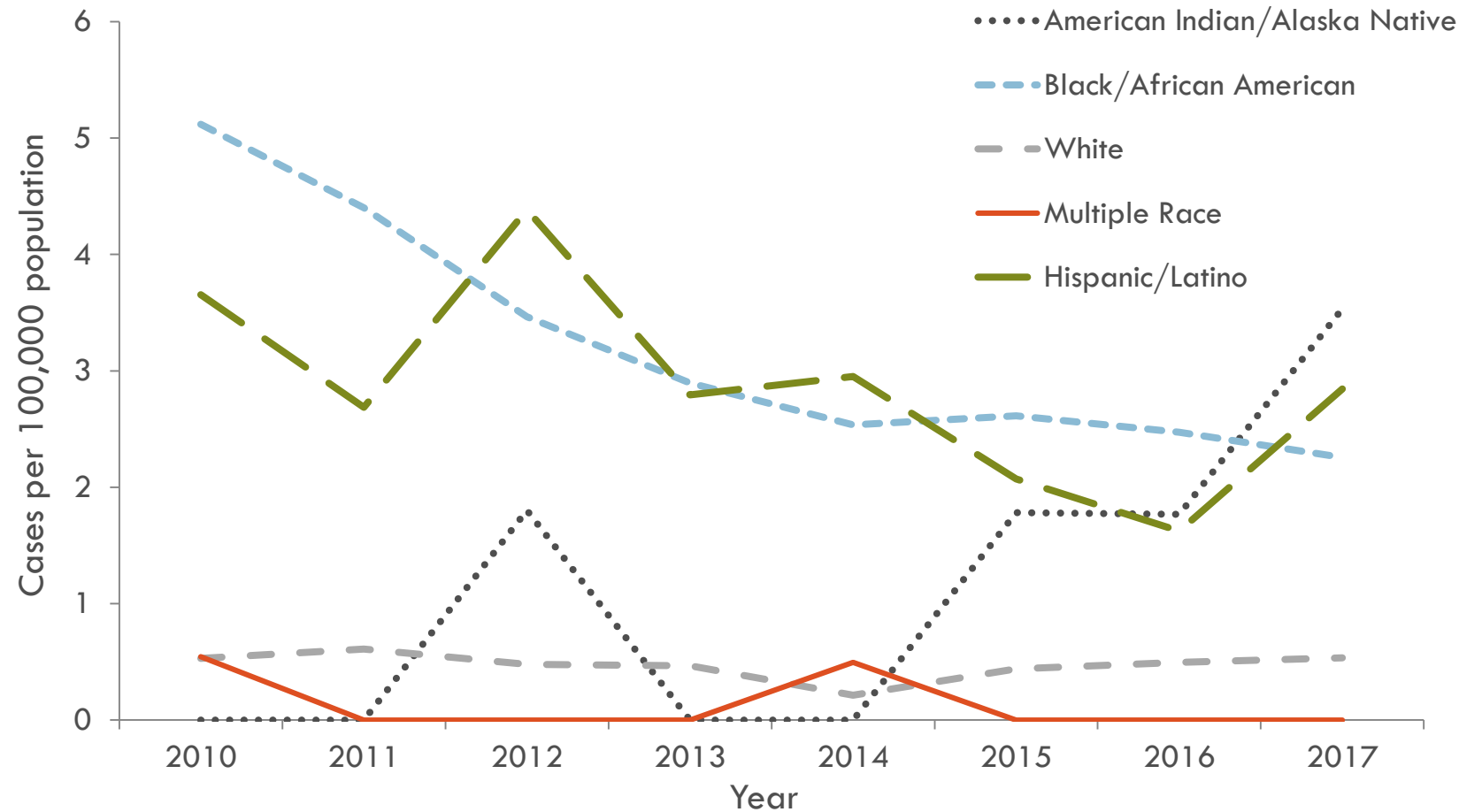


TB Rates by Race and Ethnicity

Michigan, 2010-2017

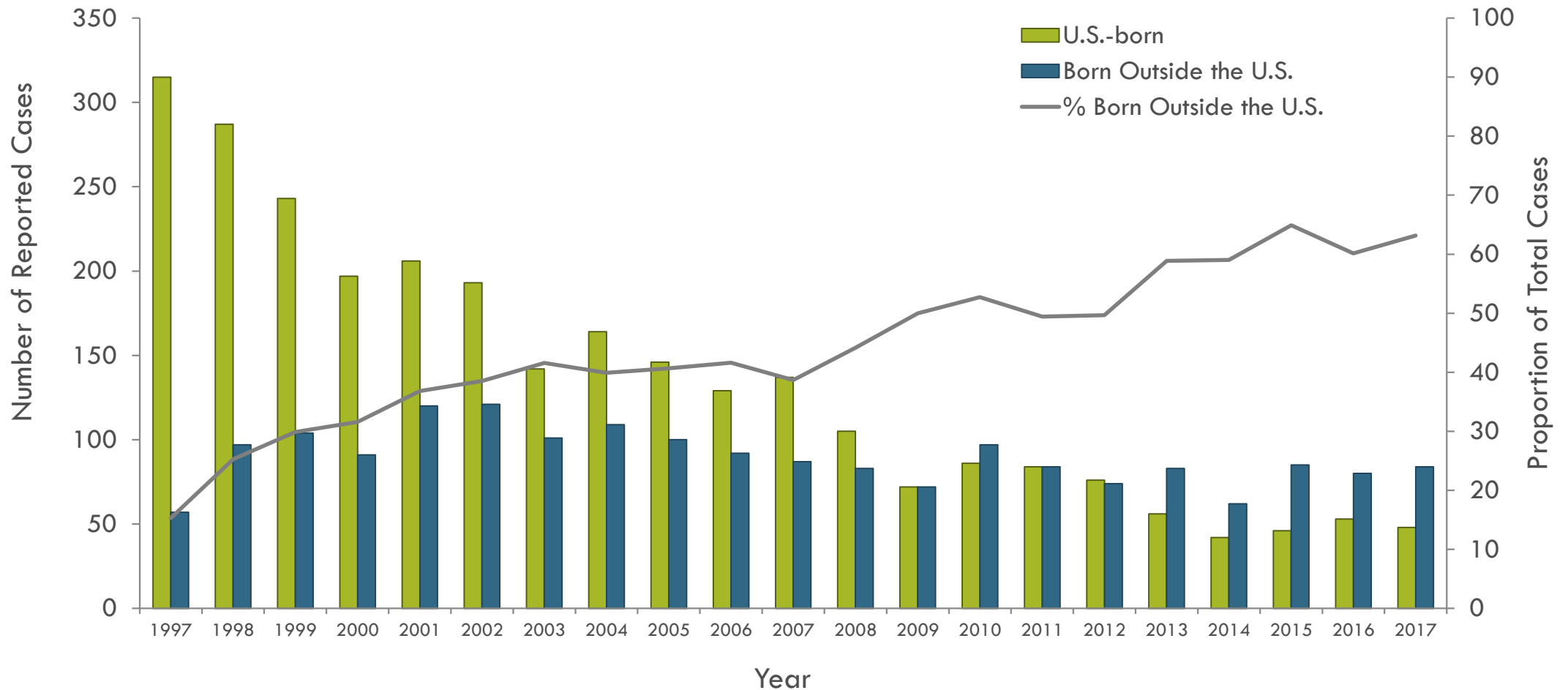
11% Hispanic or Latino at a rate of 2.8 per 100,000

1.5% American Indian or Alaska Native at a rate of 3.5 per 100,000



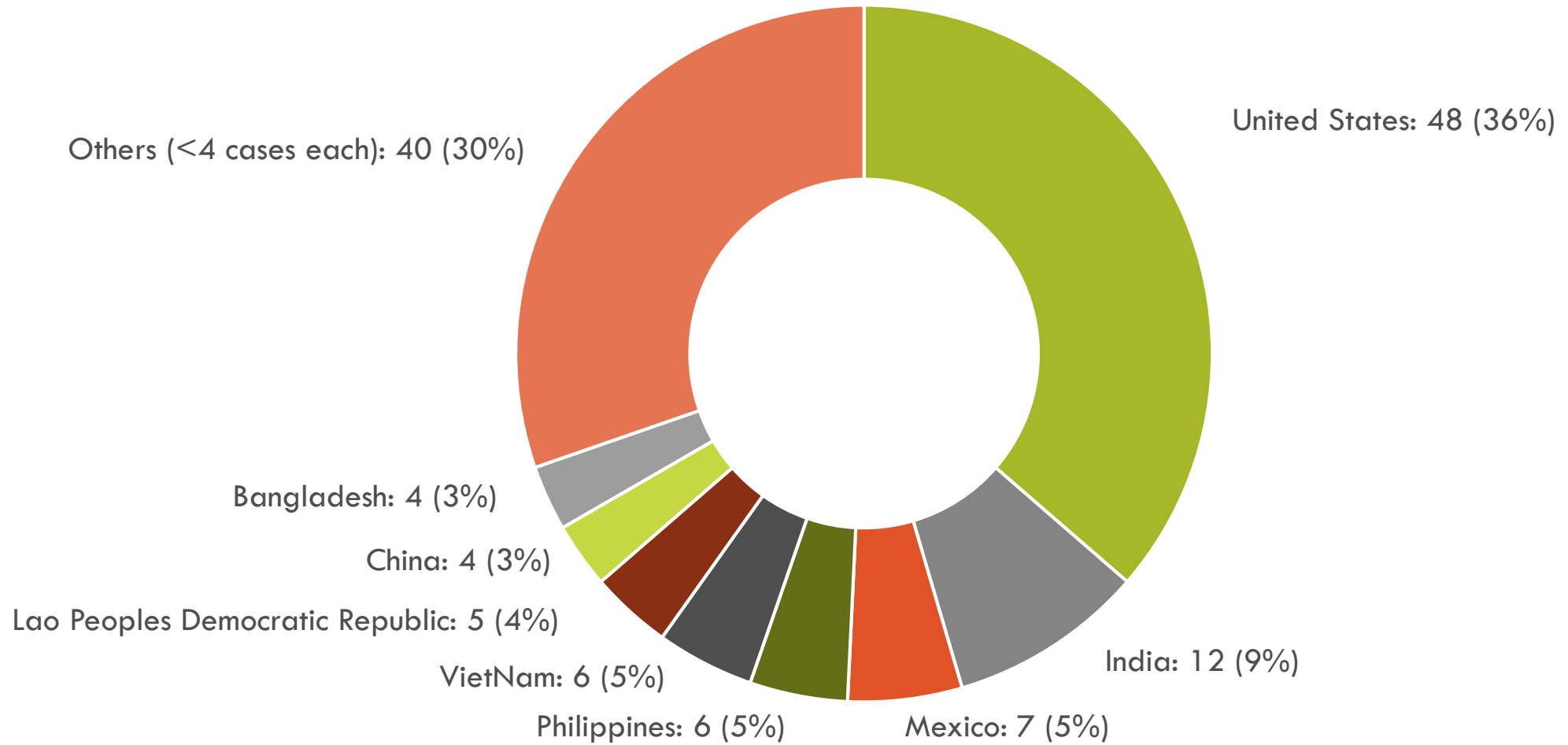
TB Cases by Country of Birth

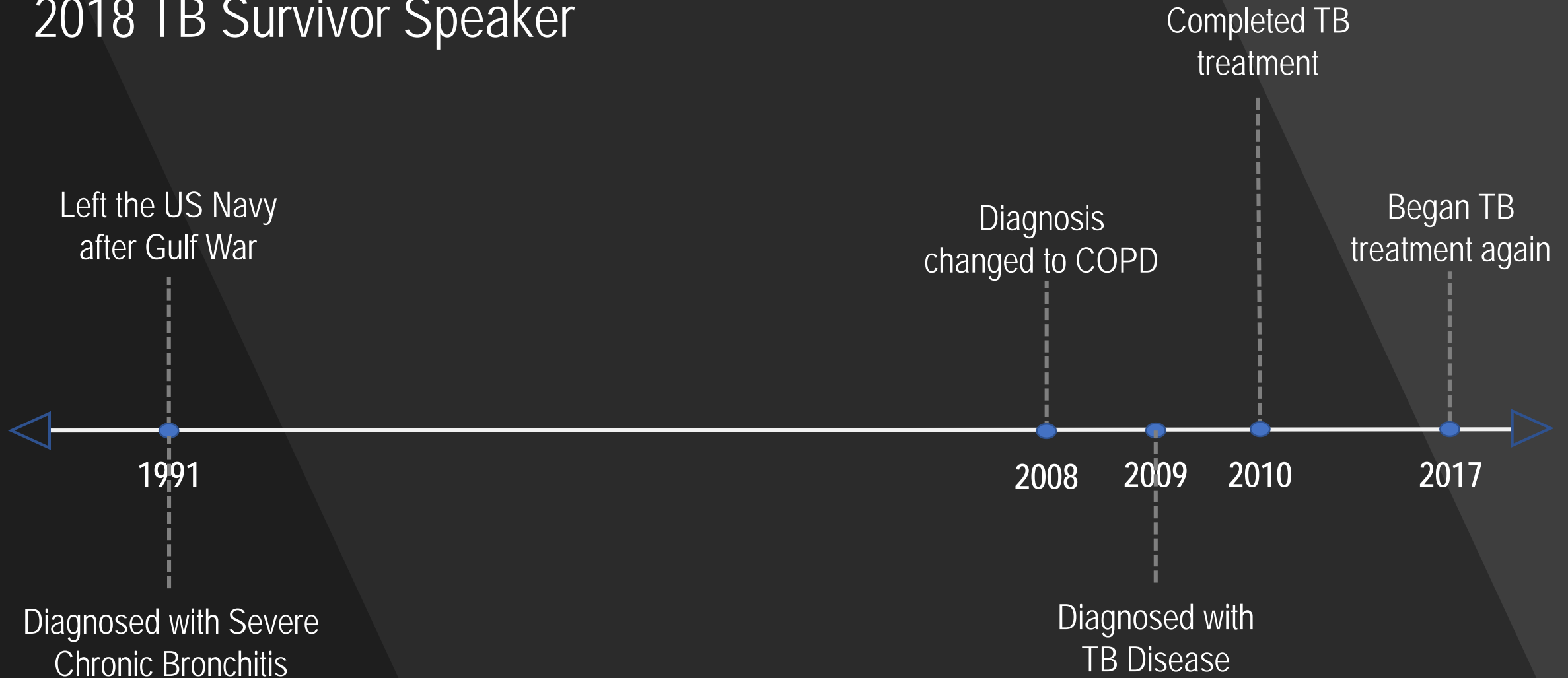

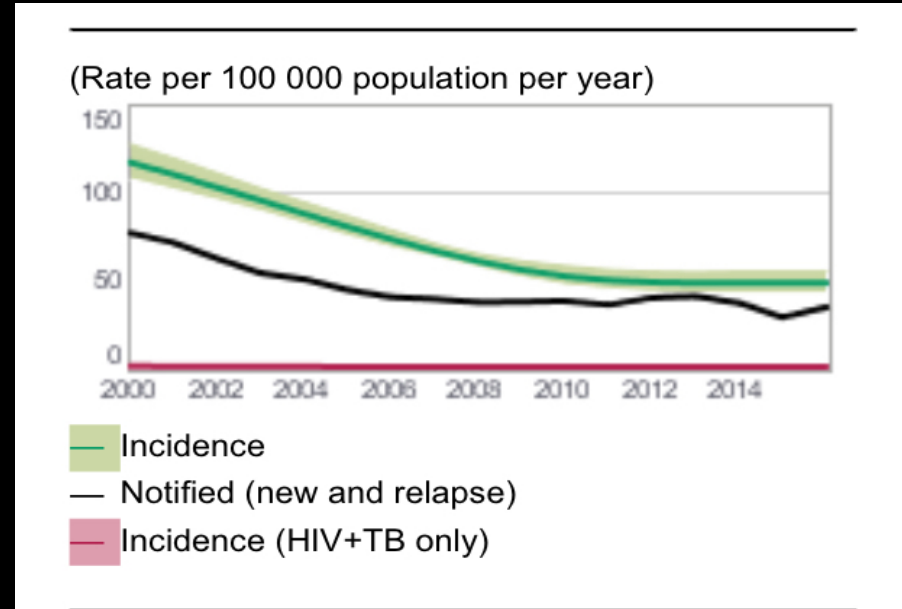
