What is Medical Subsidy? Medical Subsidy can assist with funding treatments and services for conditions your child may have. Conditions must be approved by the Adoption and Guardianship Assistance Office. Medical Subsidy can be added or updated following adoption finalization, contact your ongoing worker for additional information.

## **Medical Subsidy Funded Services:**

- Outpatient Counseling (Individual/ Family/ Group)
- Educational Services (Tutoring, Physical/ Occupational/ Speech Therapies)
- Assisted Care Services
- Behavioral Care Services
- Respite
- Travel Expenses for treatment or services
- Camps
- Orthodontic Treatment
- Medical and/or Dental costs
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Medical Supplies and Prescriptions
- Placement Outside of the Family Home (Step up/ Step Down and Residential)
- <u>Tuition Incentive Program:</u> Encourages students to complete high school by providing college tuition assistanceafter high school graduation. For more information go to https://www.michigan.gov/mistudentaid
