PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to describe the process for registering for the cognitive and psychomotor exams required for Advanced EMT or Paramedic students to become eligible for a Michigan license.

POLICY:

Any student who wishes to become licensed at the Advanced EMT or Paramedic level must pass the National Registry of EMT's (NREMT) Exam.

PROCEDURE:

- Upon completion of an Advanced EMT or Paramedic course, the student must apply to test with the NREMT at <u>www.nremt.org</u>. Both the cognitive and psychomotor exams must be taken.
- 2. Cognitive Exam
 - a. The NREMT will issue an Authorization to Test (ATT) letter that contains the student's ATT number which is required to register for the cognitive exam.
 - b. The ATT number is valid for 90 days.
 - c. The student must follow the instructions contained in the letter to register for the cognitive exam through Pearson Vue https://home.pearsonvue.com/nremt, or by calling 1-866-673-6896.
- 3. Psychomotor Exam
 - a. The NREMT will issue a Psychomotor Authorization to Test (PATT) letter that contains the student's PATT number which is required to register for the psychomotor exam.
 - b. The PATT is valid for 90 days.
 - c. To register for the psychomotor exam, which is offered at multiple sites in Michigan, the student must register at https://www.mi-emsis.org/licensure/portal#/login by completing the "National Registry Psychomotor Exam Reservation Application" and submitting payment.



- i. Sign into the portal-this may require creating an account first if not already done in class. Follow instructions on the attached Flow Sheet.
 - 1. Registration Fees are as follows: Refunds are not allowed

- ii. There is a \$25.00 rescheduling fee if a student must reschedule an exam.
 - 1. Exams can be rescheduled up to 2 weeks prior to the exam date. After that deadline, reservations may no longer be cancelled.
- iii. If an exam is cancelled due to low enrollment, weather, or other extenuating circumstances, students will be afforded the opportunity to reschedule to a future exam date at no charge.
- iv. Failure to show for an exam that has been scheduled will result in payment of the full testing fee when the student schedules another exam.
- v. Student Requirements for Psychomotor Exam Day It is strongly encouraged that students review the NREMT Psychomotor Exam Website.
 - 1. The student **must** bring to the exam:
 - a. Copy of the PATT letter from NREMT.
 - b. Government issued identification such as Driver's License.
 - 2. Student Conduct for Psychomotor Exam
 - a. Students will not be allowed to have any electronic devices or personal belongings with them at the testing stations (this includes smart phones and watches).
 - 3. Students are allowed to bring food and drink for lunch as they will not be able to leave until the exam is completed.
 - 4. Students are required to conduct themselves in a professional and ethical manner during the exam.
 - Instructions will be read to the students by the NREMT Exam Representative and will be strictly enforced.
- vi. Psychomotor Exam Complaints
 - 1. Complaints must be initiated through the NREMT Exam Representative during the exam according to the preexam instructions.
 - 2. Complaints can only be filed for the following:
 - a. The candidate feels that they have been discriminated against.



- b. There was an equipment problem or malfunction during the candidate's performance in any skill.

- vii. Psychomotor Exam Results
 - 1. Unofficial results are provided to the student on the date of the psychomotor exam.
 - a. Note: NREMT official results may have a different determination than the unofficial results. Therefore, it is important to check the NREMT website.
 - 2. Official results are posted on the NREMT website and available via individual's login account approximately four weeks after the exam.



HOW TO APPLY AND REGISTER FOR THE NREMT PSYCHOMOTOR EXAM
