SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT




On December 12, 2014, the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing issued a *Notice of Intent to Revoke* the child care center license of Birmingham Learning Center, Inc.

In settlement of all issues raised in that *Notice of Intent to Revoke*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Birmingham Learning Center, Inc. neither admits nor denies that the specific allegations set forth in the *Notice of Intent to Revoke* are true, but agrees that at least one violation of the Child Care Organizations Act, 1973 PA 116, has occurred.
- 2) Birmingham Learning Center, Inc. understands that their child care center license will be revoked, effective 30 days from the date of signature by the representative of the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing.
- 3) Birmingham Learning Center, Inc. understands that they are waiving their right to appeal the *Notice of Intent to Revoke*, and an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.
- 4) Birmingham Learning Center, Inc. agrees not to apply for a license or certificate of registration for a Child Care Organization licensed or registered under the Child Care Organization Act for a period of two years, and agrees not to be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant for a period of two years from the effective date of this agreement.
