- Meridian Complete
- Molina Dual Options MI Health Link
- Upper Peninsula Health Plan


These plans provide all health care benefits covered by Medicare and Medicaid, including prescription drugs, and some of them may offer extra covered benefits.

You will soon get information in the mail from Medicare before its Open Enrollment Period telling you your choices for receiving your Medicare benefits. If you are happy with your MI Health Link plan that provides Medicare and Medicaid services together, you do not need to pick a new Medicare plan during the Open Enrollment Period or at other times in the year. If you do nothing, you will continue to get health care and prescription drugs through your MI Health Link plan.

If you do choose to enroll in a Medicare Part D prescription drug plan or a Medicare health plan, you will no longer be enrolled in your MI Health Link plan. You will get Medicare benefits through original Medicare or a Medicare health plan, and Medicaid services through traditional Medicaid. You will get prescription drugs through a Medicare Part D plan.

If you have questions about your health care choices, information in this letter, or the Medicare Open Enrollment Period, you can call the Michigan Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program (MMAP) at 1-800-803-7174. MMAP is open Monday through Friday from 8 am – 5 pm. For questions about Medicare Part D plans, call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) or TTY: 1-800-486-2048, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
