MDHHS - Health Statistics and Reports: Over a dozen sub-tabs, most with county specific data. The sub-tab 'Health Care Statistics' will allow you to view preventable hospitalizations, medical procedures and leading hospitalizations by county.

Fall specific information – Health Care Statistics > Leading Hospitalizations > Injuries > Accidents > Accidental Falls. Sort by county under 'View Detailed Community Data'.

Rural Health Information Hub: On the home page is a tool 'Am I Rural?' which allows you to locate an area on a map or enter an address. It will generate a report that addresses program/grant eligibility, health professional shortage areas, and medically underserved areas/populations. Also contains an online library, maps, other resources.
