The Fund focuses on equipment that enhances quality of life, promote optimal health and development, and improve the mobility of the child. Since its inception in 1944, the CSN Fund has worked closely with Children with Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) to provide equipment for thousands of families.

What is the function of the CSN Fund Advisory Committee?

You will be joining a dynamic group of individuals in a family/professional partnership to:

- Provide and review recommendations for the CSN Fund's policy and guidelines for approving requests.
- Provide and review recommendations for the CSN Fund's annual budget allocation.
- Provide and review recommendations regarding grant requests and other initiatives submitted to the CSN Fund.
- Provide and review implementation plans for marketing strategies for the CSN Fund.
- Provide support in meeting the mission of the CSN Fund by reviewing and proposing recommendations for expanding the role of the CSN Fund in providing support for families that have special health care needs.

- Opportunity to provide the CSN Fund with family-centered input on equipment needs.
- Participate in decision-making regarding services and supports for children and youth with special health care needs.
- Build knowledge and skills regarding community resources for children and youth with special health care needs.
