*Shared decision making occurs when a health care provider and a patient work together to make a health care decision that is best for the patient. The optimal decision takes into account evidence-based information about available options, the provider's knowledge and experience, and the patient's values and preferences.

Dr. Sharma is a board-certified palliative care physician and attends on the inpatient palliative care consult service at the University of Washington Medical Center-Montlake. She is the Director of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion for the Cambia Palliative Care Center of Excellence and co-Chair of the American Academy of Hospice and Palliative Medicine's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee. Her research focuses on improving the quality of care for patients with serious illness through communication-based interventions with a focus on racial/ethnic minority and immigrant populations.

This presentation will cover approaches to using shared decision making in a way that facilitates health equity. Topics will include key considerations for engaging in shared decision making with marginalized populations including racial/ethnic minorities and those with low literacy or limited-English proficiency.
