(Sexual assault examinations are free of charge) Acute sexual/physical assault/abuse • Emergency medical care. • Patient advocacy. • Forensic Nurses are trained in Medical Forensic Sexual Assault Examinations and treatments for adults, adolescents, and prepubescents who have experienced inflicted injury or sexual assault. Some are SANE-A and SANE-P certified nurses. • Sexual Assault Medical Forensic Evidence Collection is available in a patient-centered design. Children who are medically stable receive a non- invasive “head to toe and everything in-between” examination that is slow, gentle, and only to their comfort level to provide a non-traumatic, normalized, and non-leading experience. Questions to the child are restricted to health and safety assessment using open-ended questions only as necessary to provide thorough medical care. • Photo documentation is used to the child’s comfort level. Thorough written documentation is also used to supplement care and treatment. • The Corewell Health Niles, St. Joseph and Watervliet forensic nurses and SANEs are part of the Multidisciplinary Team at the CAC. May also see patients for non-acute examinations or patient/family education where there are extenuating circumstances and patient’s needs are acute regardless of time frame since incident. Mott Children’s Hospital who require emergency care; including possible evidence collection in cases of sexual assault/sexual abuse. However, please contact the child protection team (available 24/7) prior to sending a child to CES if the child requires medical evaluation, but not urgently.</p> <p>INPATIENT UNITS: C.S. Mott Children’s Hospital Inpatient Units available to children requiring admission.</p> <p>OUTPATIENT CLINICS: Virtual visits are offered on a case-by-case basis. The Child Protection Team has outpatient Suspected Child Abuse and Neglect (SCAN) Clinics at the West Ann Arbor Health Center and the Pediatric Subspecialty Clinic at C.S. Mott Children’s Hospital. The clinics are staffed by two pediatricians board-certified in Child Abuse Pediatrics and a Pediatric Nurse Practitioner who is supervised by the pediatricians. Suspected victims of both physical and sexual abuse are evaluated in the clinics.</p> <p>TELEMEDICINE: Telemedicine clinic in Traverse City, MI, at Munson Medical Center, for evaluation of suspected victims of physical and/or sexual abuse.</p> <p>CASE REVIEWS: Virtual visits are offered on a case-by-case basis. Opinions regarding abuse/neglect are not provided based only upon review of medical records and photo documentation. However, a child may be evaluated in clinic (even if injuries resolved) and the evaluation will include review of medical documentation and photo documentation.</p> <p>FOSTER CARE CLINIC: Children in foster care in Western Wayne, Washtenaw, Monroe, Livingston, Jackson, Hillsdale, and Lenawee counties have been eligible to participate in services for an initial medical exam at the U of M Foster Care Pediatric Clinic on a limited basis when referred by the Health Liaison Officer (HLO).</p> <p>The Child Protection Team provides guidance in cases of suspected Medical Child Abuse.</p> <p>The Child Protection Team is available 24/7 for consultation via phone.</p>

Frequent concerns such as head trauma, acute (fresh) injuries, emergent sexual assault, and others may be directed to the Pediatric Emergency Department at Helen DeVos Children’s Hospital for immediate evaluation and CCP coordination. Arrangements for forensic evidence (rape kit) collection is done on a case-by-case basis. Non-emergent but urgent concerns will also be addressed by CCP Triage on a case-by-case basis. Please call CCP triage to utilize any of these services.</p> <p>INPATIENT CONSULTATION: Center for Child Protection physicians consult for children that require admission to the General Pediatric floors, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, and Pediatric Burn unit.</p> <p>OUTPATIENT CLINICS: The Center for Child Protection is located at 330 Barclay Ave. Grand Rapids, MI. Children are seen for any form of abuse or neglect. The Center for Child Protection has also partnered with several Michigan Children's Advocacy Centers (Barry, Clare, Gratiot, Montcalm, Ionia, Isabella, Oceana, Newaygo, Lake, Osceola, and Mecosta counties) to provide medical evaluation at our 330 Barclay address. On-site medical services are provided at the Allegan, Muskegon and Ottawa County Children's Advocacy Centers for children living in those counties.</p> <p>Other Services:</p> <p>Child pornography reviews- Please contact Center for Child Protection Triage for specific information.</p> <p>Case reviews- At this time, a medical opinion is not provided based solely upon review of medical records and photodocumentation. A child can be seen for an outpatient appointment with injuries that have resolved if there is photodocumentation of previous injury or evidence of previous injury on the body (healed scarring). At that time, review of previous medical records can be done and used in the formation of a diagnosis.</p> <p>Photo-documentation of acute injuries- As arranged by CCP triage coordinators- call for further information.</p> <p>Education and Training- Addressing the needs of CPS, law enforcement and medical providers. Please call us.</p> <p>CASE REVIEWS: Dr. Brown is authorized to complete case reviews for MDHHS regarding medical care received anywhere in the Bronson system. They receive referrals from CPS, physicians and law enforcement for physical exams in the child abuse clinic at UMH-Sparrow. In the clinic, the physicians provide child abuse exams and write reports based on their interviews and exams to CPS, PCPs and/or law enforcement. Dr. Guertin is available for inpatient consults when he is in town; he works on a per diem basis. Dr. Guertin is normally available two Thursdays each month. Dr. Yurkovich is available almost every Thursday.</p>

This care includes medical attention, a detailed forensic exam and prophylactic medication as indicated. The Forensic Examiners (FEs) are specially trained to perform medical forensic examinations of adolescent and adult victims of acute sexual assault. They collect evidence from suspects in police custody and work with victims. They are also trained in giving court testimony.</p>
