



The proposed curriculum for CP education in Michigan is a culmination of existing curricula; current practices of community paramedic programs that are functioning as special studies within the state of Michigan; requests for skills from stakeholders throughout the state; and evaluation of national trends in MIH-CP care.

Community colleges and proprietary schools accredited to conduct initial education at the paramedic level are invited to conduct a community paramedic class in conjunction with MDHHS. The proposed curriculum is a guideline only. Evaluation of the program, participants and participant competency post education will be used to evaluate the curriculum and guide applicable changes.
