BLOOD DRAW APPOINTMENT PRECAUTIONS



Before Your Blood Draw Appointment:

✓ Complete the online survey to reduce time at your appointment. This should take approximately 45 minutes or more.

Project Staff are Required to:

- ✓ Screen themselves for COVID-19 symptoms and exposure before every work shift.
- ✓ Wear face coverings and gloves.
- ✓ Sanitize appointment areas, equipment, and surfaces between each participant.
- ✓ When possible, remain six feet from participants.

During Your Blood Draw Appointment:

- ✓ Wait until project staff bring you in for your appointments.
- ✓ Answer COVID-19 screening questions that one of our project staff will ask you.
- ✓ Have your temperature taken before proceeding with your appointment.
- ✓ Wear a face covering that covers your mouth and nose. Face coverings will be available if you do not have one.

WATER SAMPLING VISIT PRECAUTIONS



During Your Station's Water Sampling Visit, MDHHS Environmental Sanitarians are Required to:

- ✓ Screen themselves for COVID-19 symptoms and exposure before every work shift.
- √ Wear gloves and a face covering that covers your mouth and nose.
- ✓ When possible, remain six feet from fire station personnel.

During Your Station's Water Sampling Visit:



- ✓ The point of contact for your station will answer COVID-19 screening questions asked by MDHHS environmental sanitarians during the water sampling.
- ✓ When possible, all fire station personnel will need to maintain personal distance of six feet from the MDHHS environmental sanitarians.
