


### ***Epinephrine Auto Injector (0.15 mg) Shortage***

1. Follow all care and treatment guidelines for **Anaphylaxis/Allergic Reaction** or **Pediatric Respiratory Distress, Failure or Arrest Protocol**, according to patient condition.
2. The treatment in this protocol is applicable to providers who have MCA approval for Epinephrine Auto-Injector usage.
3. Epinephrine Auto-Injector 0.3 mg may be given in instances of significant distress or impending respiratory failure in shock and:
  - a. ALS is not readily available
  - b. Patient is greater than 15 kg (about 35 pounds),
  -  c. For patients less than 15 kg, contact medical control prior to administration, if possible.
