

FAQ Case Specifics

This FAQ document will record questions posed to the CWCS team which are case specific (but identifying information removed for confidentiality).

County: Jackson

Question: Mom has 3 children (Child 1 age 15, Child 2 age 2 and Child 3 age 6mo). Child 3 was born positive for marijuana. Child 2 and Child 3 currently live in mom's home. Child 1 lives with grandmother in the same town, effective 1 week ago. Mom has been working with Prevention Only Services for 2 weeks. Mom and Grandmother want services for Child 1. Mom is also receiving services for Child 2 and Child 3. Is Child 1 FFPSA Title IV-E Prevention Services eligible and which household should Child 1 be recorded in?

Answer: Household 1 is mom, Child 1, Child 2, and Child 3. Household 2 is grandmother and Child 1. Child 1 is eligible for FFPSA Title IV-E Prevention services as Child 1 is a sibling of an eligible child (Child 3). Caseworker should add the FFPSA Title IV-E Prevention eligibility information for all 3 children and add corresponding case services to the case.

County: BSC 4 Case Reads

Question: Dad was in foster care and was in YAVFC for a short time but lost eligibility at age < 26. Dad fathered a child while in YAVFC and baby was born after YAVFC closed. Mom and Dad are together but dad is currently in jail. Is baby eligible for FFPSA Title IV-E Prevention Services with mom?

Answer: Yes – baby is eligible as a child of a parent who was in care until the parent reaches age 26.

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
