HEPATITIS A IS A SERIOUS LIVER DISEASE CAUSED BY A VIRUS THAT IS FOUND IN THE FECES (POOP) OF INFECTED PEOPLE. IT CAN EASILY SPREAD FROM PERSON-TO-PERSON AND CAUSE LIVER DISEASE LASTING A FEW WEEKS TO A SERIOUS ILLNESS LASTING MANY MONTHS. IN SOME CASES, IT CAN BE DEADLY.

Protect yourself against this outbreak by getting your first dose of hep A vaccine.

YOU ARE MORE LIKELY TO BE INFECTED IF YOU:

- USE DRUGS (INJECTION, NON-INJECTION, OR MARIJUANA)
- HAVE SEX WITH AN INFECTED PERSON
- LIVE WITH OR HAVE CLOSE CONTACT WITH AN INFECTED PERSON
- TOUCH OR EAT FOOD OR DRINK
 THAT SOMEONE WITH HEPATITIS
 A INFECTION HANDLED

YOU CAN REDUCE YOUR RISK OF EXPOSURE BY:

- THOROUGHLY WASHING YOUR
 HANDS AND GENITALS WITH SOAPY
 WATER AFTER ANY SEXUAL
 ACTIVITY
- USING PROTECTION DURING ANY SEXUAL ACTIVITY INCLUDING ORAL OR ANAL SEX
- CHANGING CONDOMS BETWEEN ORAL AND ANAL SEX
- NOT SHARING SEX TOYS
