Policy and reporting requirements for the attending provider specific to Inpatient (IPH) and Outpatient Hospital (OPH)*

Policy Background	
<p>Michigan Medicaid Provider Manual Chapter Billing and Reimbursement for Institutional Providers Section 2.3.B Attending Provider, MSA 21-45. The attending provider NPI is a requirement for all claims submitted within the institutional claim format with one exception. Hospital-owned ambulance Medicaid enrolled providers submitting Emergency Ambulance Transport claims may report the attending provider NPI, however, completion of this field is not required.</p> <p>If the attending NPI is not reported, not enrolled in Community Health Automated Medicaid Processing System (CHAMPS), not enrolled on the date of service, or enrolled with a specialty/subspecialty other than what is identified below, the claim will be denied. This also applies to out-of-state providers and emergency services. Providers are encouraged to utilize the CHAMPS Provider Verification Tool to verify enrollment.</p>

<p>Claims denied for the attending provider can be identified with the following Claim Adjustment Reason Codes (CARC) and Remittance Advice Remark Codes (RARC):</p>	
<p>CARC B7 & RARC M143 The provider is not certified/eligible to be paid for this procedure/service on this date of service</p>	<p>Is the provider enrolled in CHAMPS? Is the provider's enrollment active for the dates of service being billed on the claim? Verify in the CHAMPS Provider Verification Tool</p>
<p>CARC 183 & RARC N767 or N574 The provider is not eligible to bill for the services</p>	<p>Is the NPI reported the individual/type 1 NPI? Is the provider one of the allowed provider types?</p>
<p>CARC 16 & RARC N253 Missing/Incomplete/Invalid attending provider</p>	<p>Is there an attending NPI reported on the claim?</p>
<p>Attending physician for these claim types must be a Physician (MD/DO). See below for a full listing of CHAMPS enrolled provider type specialty and subspecialty.</p>
