HFA rural enrollment: pregnancy to 3 months of age and services family until child reaches the age of 4. Visits range weekly to monthly.

Infant Mental Health Home Visiting works with parents/caregivers that have difficulty forming a positive attachment with their infant, toddler which can affect their social, emotional, behavioral, and cognitive development. Services are provided by Infant Mental Health providers. Enrollment: pregnancy through turning age 3, has income guidelines. Visits are usually weekly or bi-weekly.

Family Spirit was developed for and by American Indian communities. Supports health of family and builds strong and healthy parents. Enrollment: pregnancy through 3-5 years of age for families in the respective Tribal Service population. Visit range is weekly to monthly.

MIHP offers home visits from caring and trustworthy social workers and nurses who work in partnership with families to ensure they feel supported through pregnancy and parenthood. Enrollment: Medicaid-eligible pregnant persons and infants through 12 months of age may enroll. Services continue throughout pregnancy and up to 18 months of age based on the needs of the infant and their caregiver. Visits are offered monthly but may be more frequent.
