RESOURCE GUIDE INTRODUCTION

MDHHS Division of HIV and STD Programs, HIV Care and Prevention

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, Division of HIV and STD Programs, HIV Care and Prevention Section (MDHHS) Ryan White (RW) Program provides a comprehensive system of HIV primary medical care, essential support services, and medications for low-income people living with HIV who are uninsured and underserved. MDHHS partners with health departments, hospitals, universities, and, community-based organizations to provide core medical and support services to people living with HIV throughout all life stages, including specialty care during pregnancy.

This resource guide contains a list of HIV medical providers including their available services offered throughout the state with additional support service information for pregnant women, new mothers and infants.

HIV SUPPORT SERVICE CATEGORIES

**Support services vary by county*

Medical Case Management – the provision of a range of client-centered activities focused on improving health outcomes in support of the HIV care continuum

Medical Nutrition Therapy – includes: Nutrition assessment and screening, Dietary/nutritional evaluation, Food and/or nutritional supplements per medical provider’s recommendation, and Nutrition education and/or counseling

Medical Transportation Services – the provision of nonemergency transportation that enables an eligible client to access or be retained in core medical and support services

Mental Health Services – the provision of outpatient psychological and psychiatric screening, assessment, diagnosis, and counseling

Non-medical Case Management – the provision of a range of client-centered activities focused on improving access to and retention in needed core medical and support services

Outpatient and Ambulatory Health Services – the provision of professional diagnostic and therapeutic services rendered by a licensed physician, physician’s assistant, clinical nurse specialist, or nurse practitioner in an outpatient setting

Oral Healthcare – activities include outpatient diagnosis, prevention, and therapy provided by dental health care professionals, including general dental practitioners, dental specialists, dental hygienists, and licensed dental assistants

Michigan HIV/AIDS Drug Assistance Program – currently covers HIV-specific and related medicines, as well as vaccines

The Michigan Drug Assistance Program Premium Assistance Program – designed to help clients obtain or maintain a Qualified Health Plan through the Health Insurance Marketplace, a Medicare Part C Plan (Advantage Plan), (Prescription Plan) or a COBRA Plan

Insurance Assistance Program – includes premium assistance for Medigap policies and Medicare supplement plans

Psychosocial Support Services – Psychosocial Support Services provide group or individual support and counseling services to assist clients to address behavioral and physical health concerns

Substance Abuse Treatment Services-Outpatient – the provision of outpatient services for the treatment of drug or alcohol use disorders.

Linguistic Services – includes interpretation and translation activities, both oral and written, to eligible clients

Health Insurance Premium and Cost-sharing Assistance – provides health insurance for comprehensive primary care and pharmacy coverage for low income clients, providing a full range of HIV medications; paying co-pays (including co-pays for prescription eyewear for conditions related to HIV infection) and deductibles on behalf of the client

Health Education/Risk Reduction – the provision of education to clients living with HIV about HIV transmission and how to reduce the risk of HIV transmission

Food Bank/Home-delivered – refers to the provision of actual food items, hot meals, nutritional supplements, or a voucher program to purchase food. This also includes the provision of essential non-food items that are limited to the following: Personal hygiene products, Household cleaning supplies, water filtration/purification systems in communities where issues of water safety exist

Emergency Financial Assistance – provides limited one-time or short-term payments to assist a client with an urgent need for essential items or services necessary to improve health outcomes, including utilities, housing, food, transportation, and medication

Early Intervention Services – identify individuals at points of entry and provides access to services and provision of referral services, linkage to care, and health education and literacy training that enable clients to navigate the HIV system of care

Child Care Services – supports intermittent childcare for the children living in the household of persons living with HIV to enable those clients to attend medical visits, related appointments, and/or related meetings, groups, or training sessions

Housing Services – provides transitional, short-term, or emergency housing assistance to enable a client or family to gain or maintain outpatient/ambulatory health services and treatment, including temporary assistance necessary to prevent homelessness and to achieve or maintain access to medical care
