



Michigan QI At-A-Glance for Consultants

IQIP is CDC's national, provider site-level immunization quality improvement (QI) program.

The purpose of IQIP is to promote and support the implementation of provider site-level immunization quality improvement strategies designed to increase vaccine uptake among children and adolescents in adherence to the routine schedule recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).

QI Consultants provide technical assistance to provider sites to support four QI strategies to improve immunization priorities and increase vaccine administration.

Michigan QI strategies

- Schedule the next immunization visit before the patient leaves the provider site
- Leverage IIS functionality to improve immunization practice
- Give a strong vaccine recommendation (emphasize HPV vaccine if provider has adolescent patients)
- Promote Flu Vaccine

Two QI strategies are selected to implement or improve (if already implemented) during the QI cycle

Michigan 12-month QI Process

QI Site visit

- Discuss provider workflow
- Review initial coverage levels
- Select 2 QI strategies
- Provide technical assistance
- Develop action items for the 2 QI strategies

2-month and 6-month check-ins

- Review progress toward strategy implementation
- Provide additional technical assistance
- Update Action Items

12-month follow-up

- Review progress toward strategy implementation
- Provide technical assistance
- Review year-over-year coverage & denominator changes
