Health Status Assessment Overview

- The State Health Assessment in Michigan is using the MAPP model for assessment activities—aiming to improve public health, prioritizing health needs, and identifying resources to meet those needs
- Provided overview of the Health Status Assessment, the timeline for this work, and the role of this Committee

Indicator Selection

- Participants worked as a group to discuss indicators. At this meeting the participants were able to discuss indicators falling under the following categories:
 - Social Determinants of Health;
 - Health Status and Health Outcomes;
 - Environmental Conditions;
 - Social and Mental Health; and
 - Behavioral Risk Factors.
- For each category, the group reviewed the draft list of indicators, provided suggestions to fill any identified gaps, and then sticker voted to prioritize which of the listed indicators to include in this assessment.

Next Steps and Wrap-Up

- MPHI will schedule a second meeting to discuss remaining categories of indicators, including:

- Morbidity and Mortality;
- Injury and Violence Prevention;
- Communicable Disease;
- Chronic Disease; and
- Mental and Child Health.
- MPHI will work with MDHHS Epidemiologists and explore other existing data sources to gather available data.
- MPHI will organize the data and reconvene this group; at that time, this group will review data to define findings that should be elevated to the larger partnership group for purposes of prioritization.
