1. Someone in your neighborhood is sick and can't walk his dog.		√	<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would offer to walk the dog if my family says it's OK. I could ask some friends if they can help on other days, too.</i></p>
2. Your younger brother fell and isn't moving.	√		<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would get help from an adult right away. If no adult were near, I would call 911.</i></p>
3. You don't know what a word means in your book.		√	<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would try to find the word in a child's dictionary, either in a book or online. If I couldn't find the word or didn't understand the meaning, I would ask an older friend or an adult for help.</i></p>
4. One of your friends doesn't want to play with you any more. He or she doesn't play with anyone and seems very sad.	√	√	<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would ask my friend what was wrong and if I could help. If he or she didn't want my help, I would tell an adult I trust right away because it is a disturbing situation.</i></p>
5. A friend of your older brother keeps asking you to go for a ride in his car. You don't want to go.	√		<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would not go for a ride. I would tell a parent or other trusted adult right away. I would ask for help.</i></p>
6. You are at your aunt's house. She is coming in the door with a big sack of groceries.		√	<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would offer to help carry some of the groceries.</i></p>
7. An adult you don't know asks you to go with him to help him find his dog.	√		<p><b>What would you do?</b>  <i>I would not go with him. I would tell an adult right away.</i></p>
