Subject: Ending of the Plan First! Family Planning Waiver

Effective: As Indicated

Programs Affected: Plan First!

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify all providers that the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) will not seek a renewal of *Plan First!*, Michigan's Section 1115 Demonstration Waiver for family planning services. The waiver is set to expire June 30, 2016.

MDHHS stopped accepting new applications for *Plan First!* effective April 1, 2014 as part of a planned phase-out of the waiver. Current *Plan First!* enrollees:

- Were actively enrolled in Plan First! on April 1, 2014, and
- Have not had their eligibility for full medical coverage determined.

MDHHS has taken steps to review eligibility for all current *Plan First!* enrollees to determine whether they are eligible for any other Michigan Medicaid programs including the Healthy Michigan Plan. *Plan First!* coverage for all enrollees will end when their eligibility for other programs has been determined. If the determination is not final, or if there is a timely appeal pending, *Plan First!* eligibility for some individuals may extend past June 30, 2016.
