## Child & Youth Outcomes

#### School age (K-12)

- Integration with peers in school and community environments
- Meaningful educational and extra-curricular participation
- Optimal physical and behavioral health
- Skills to support an individual's post-secondary goal
- Family support network is robust

## Adult Outcomes

#### 18 years and older

- Integration & inclusion within
  the preferred community
- Maximum independence achieved through policy & practice that promotes selfadvocacy, self-determination, and self-management
- Employment, education, housing, health care, and family meets the wants and needs of the individual
