

Michigan PA 161 programs reduce oral health disparities for underserved Michigan residents by using a dental hygienist to provide oral health education and preventive services in nontraditional public health settings with remote supervision by a dentist.


148,000 Preventive Services Provided between Oct. 1, 2016 & Sept. 30, 2017
