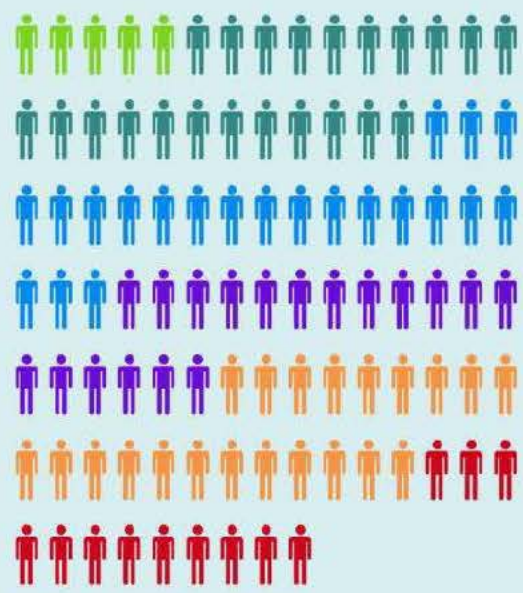

### How do PA 161 Programs Help?

Michigan PA 161 programs reduce oral health disparities for underserved Michigan residents by using a dental hygienist to provide oral health education and preventive services in non-traditional public health settings with remote supervision by a dentist.

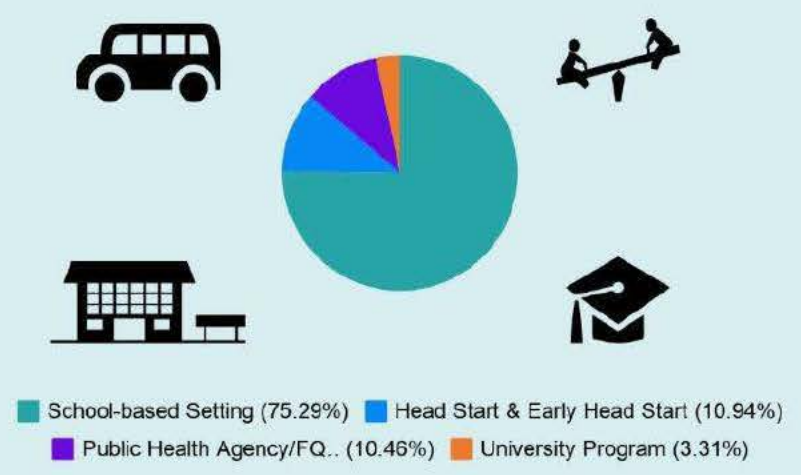
148,000 Preventive Services Provided between Oct. 1, 2016 & Sept. 30, 2017



- Adults Screened (5.43%)
- Children Screened (21.70%)
- Child & Adult Cleanings (21.45%)
- Sealants Placed (18.07%)
- Fluoride Varnish Treatments (21.17%)
- Referred to a Dentist (12.17%)
