MDHHS is providing you with public notice and invitation to participate in efforts to improve safety in care in Michigan's Child Caring Institutions (CCIs). Michigan reached out to national experts, Annie E. Casey Foundation, Casey Family Programs, and Building Bridges Initiative, to conduct a review and make recommendations regarding the safety and quality of care being provided in CCIs; the report, including recommendations for reform, are attached.
