WHEREAS, infant nutrition is considered a public health issue and it is important for hospitals, businesses, community agencies and coalitions to work together to provide consistent and accurate information to help ensure successful breastfeeding; and,

WHEREAS, during this month, we join with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, the Michigan Breastfeeding Network, and community breastfeeding coalitions to broaden the public's understanding of the critical impact breastfeeding has on providing a strong foundation for life for an infant;
