- 2. Section 6(2)(f): Added language that requires a planning area to have an occupancy rate of 85% or more to be able to begin operation of a new NH-HLTCU or to increase the number of beds at an existing licensed NH-HLTCU pursuant to the new design model.
- 3. Section 14(1): Updated dates.
