- Medium to large vaccination sites




Slight decrease in vaccine resistance

Leading concerns


Among the unvaccinated, side effects are growing as the leading concerns; fewer other concerns



Factors that may increase likelihood


30% of the unvaccinated reported convenience as a factor that may increase their likelihood to get vaccinated


Would any of the following options make it more likely for you to get vaccinated in the near future?

Of the unvaccinated, Black respondents report less resistance to vaccination than white respondents; convenience is a more important factor for Black respondents




