The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services' request, dated February 20, 2019, for an extension of Michigan's Waiver for Children with Serious Emotional Disturbances (MI-17.R01.M01). The current waiver authority expires on March 31, 2019.

The waiver extension is being requested in order to allow the state time to work towards integrating coverage of all services and eligible populations served through its current §1915(b) and §1915(c) waivers serving people with serious mental illness, substance use disorders, intellectual and developmental disabilities, and serious emotional disturbances.

We are granting your request for an extension of this waiver authority to extend through June 30, 2019. We look forward to continuing communication towards the state's integration.
