- COVID Supplemental Block Grant approved. Currently awaiting the questions and revisions for the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Supplemental Block Grant in which an RFP will be released for tribal partners and urban Indian health centers to apply for funds to implement evidence-based practices. The release is expected to take place around the beginning of October 2021. Drug Overdose Prevention Grant – Lisa mentioned that this grant was applied for and awarded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). Use of this grant will take place in Calhoun, Genesee and Wayne counties, through coalitions and prevention providers which will include Naloxone training and distribution. Looking to hire a project coordinator. Partnering with Prevention Network (PN) who will be offering technical assistance TA and mini grants. SOR II Continuation Grant is approved - Logan explained that year two will continue as year one and explained the various projects related to this grant and the process. Pregnant and Parenting and Women's Pilot, and PDO Grant – Angie mentioned the status of these grants.

Participation in national drive sober or get pulled starting this week. BAC .08 sunset and expungement bills are going through governor’s desk. All of funding is contingent upon having .08. Non-repeat OWI offenders will have the opportunity to seek expungement of their first offense five years after probation ends. Working on FY22 grants and brainstorming for FY23.

Harm Reduction Summit – The *Harm Reduction Summit* starting next week for 5 days in the morning. Updating the directory, 71 sites are operating and 1/3 of them in Southeast Michigan. Latest one will be open in Monroe by Salvation Army and Harbor Light.
