- Marijuana Use Lisa Coleman The Marijuana Prevention Workgroup has completed the Marijuana Strategic Plan and it will be sent to Communications for approval
- Tobacco and E-Cigarettes Must be 21 years of age is the rule of the feds that individuals must be 21 to purchase cigarettes. At the state level, the age is still 18 years of age. Also following several bill including flavor products, licensing required for ENDS, Age 21 and age of majority rule.
- Alcohol Patrick Hindman Factsheets available to share and follow bills addressing removing violation after 7 years for license holders and hours of sales.
- Gambling Disorder Alia Lucas Those who attended annual gambling symposium shared positive feedback. Excellent workshop by Lakeshore PIHP on how to address gambling prevention using Strategic Prevention Framework. State needs to step up on epi data on gambling.
